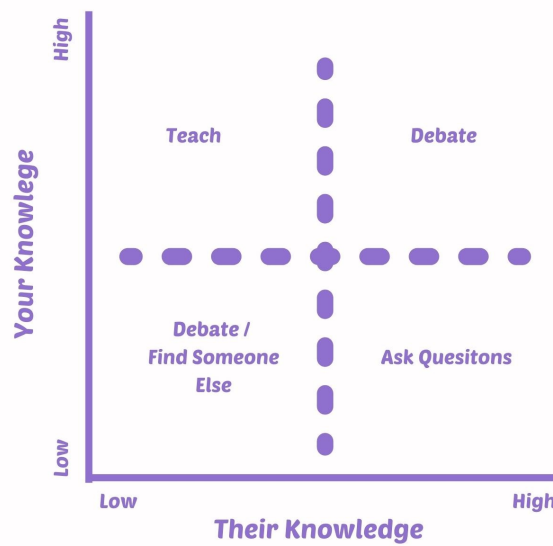


How to Make Better Decisions

5. What role are you playing in this scenario: Student, teacher, or peer?



Think about your role in the situation:

Student = ask questions

Teacher = teach

Peer—debate
